Each pickup shows the timecode in the recording, what was heard, what was in the reference, and the category. Every pickup corresponds to a beep at –24 dB in the MARKED MP3 and an INDEX entry in the CUE sheet.

What this demo proves. The reader planted 6 deliberate misreads in this take (scores, so that, hollow, dropped 'rather', added 'all', dropped 'not'). ProofReady caught every one of them — **plus four additional misreads** the reader did not know they had made: *struggle* for *struggled* at 1:02, *not* for *nor* at 1:14, and a small drop+addition around '*and that government*' at 2:07. That's the entire case for ProofReady on a single chapter: every defect a careful listener would catch, plus the ones they wouldn't.
